The JAMS Green Team serves to promote sustainable practices in our HQ and Resolution Centers, with the goal of creating an environmentally sensitive, resource efficient, and socially responsible workplace in a cost and effective way.

We mobilize efforts to encourage associates to adopt "green" practices so that JAMS can reduce its environmental "footprint." Some of the great ways JAMmers have been able to achieve that in the past year, despite the challenges of the COVID-19 global pandemic, are listed below:

JAMS Green Team Efforts

Reuse & Recycle

- Decreased use of paper, including printing, as we've shifted to electronic forms.
- Reduction of mailing packages, unless requested by panelists.
- Use of reusable PPE, including masks, lunch bags, and utensils.
- Use of mugs, reusable towels, and installed hand sanitizer units to reduce single-use plastic.
- Use of water units with filters to reduce plastic bottle consumption.
- Participation in local recycling programs and rollout of nespresso machines with recyclable coffee pods.

Energy Conservation

- Shift to laptops which has provided greater flexibility and decrease in power usage.
- Shift from Shoretel telephones to FUZE communication platform which has provided additional ways to communicate and workplace flexibility.
- Reduction of e-waste as RCs are cleaning server storages and participating in local e-waste recycling events.
- Reduction of power used by large printing units as the equipment has been set up to go into hibernation mode.
